Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to John Hanson Sen nine pounds, eleven Shillings and three pence specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per Certificate of Richard Dallam's Commissary of Harford County adjuted by the Deputy Auditor the 30 of August 1787 -

That the said Treasurer pay unto Robert Peter Esquire Three hundred and eighteen pounds, two Shillings and ten pence in such Certificates as were issued for claims against persons convicted of Treason per Account against Adam Stewart's Estate, passed by the Auditor General the 19th instant

The Council adjourned till tomorrow morning
