Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Dyre Betton Fifty three pounds, four shillings and one penny half penny current money per account passed by the Auditor General

That the said Treasurer pay to Elie Valtelle Twenty one pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence per account passed by the Auditor General

Ordered that the Justices of the several Counties hereafter mentioned pay to Mr George Byrce Collector of the Nottingham District the Sums respectively annexed to the same for an allowance of one penny on each Hoghead of Tobacco inspected in the said Counties, and shipped from the District aforesaid agreeably to an Act entitled "An Act to regulate the inspection of Tobacco" viz^t
