Musters rolls of the Maryland Line, and other Documents that
may be offered to them, and to make out in the name of each
person who would have been entitled to the same under the
acts of Congress or Laws of this State, had application been
made in time, the amount of pay or depreciation of pay that
may appear to be due him for his services in the late Contin-
ental Army &c. We do direct the Auditor General to issue
Certificates of Depreciation to the following persons - and
to deposit them in the hands of the Treasurer

Andrew Malone - Corp^t discharged 10 Jan'y 1780 -

Certificate from Col^o Woolford of serving
three years, dated 8 January 1780.

Bartholomew Gallehan - enlisted 7 Decem^r 1776. discharged
the 7th Decem^r 1779 per Certificate of Col^o Gumbly
dated 4 April 1789

Michael Cosma Sgt^t discharged 29 Jan'y or 3 Feb'y
per Certificates of Col^o Woolford and Gen^l
Gist of the above dates

George Kelly Soldier. discharged 4 April 1780 Certificates
of Capt Jonathan Morris & Col^o Gumbly the above dates

Daniel Thally - Soldier discharged 9 Decem^r 1779 per Certificate
of Col^o Jos^o C. Hall

Roger Skiffington enlisted 10 Jan'y 1778 for the war, was
missing 16 August 1780 at the battle
of Landen - wounded & taken prisoner
