appears by a Deposition of Capt Daniel Cresap, and was  
discharged the 9<sup>th</sup> of August 1779.

Henry Ridgely Esquire appeared in the  
Council room, and qualified as a Member of the Council  
before Allen Duym Esquire one of the Justices of the  
Peace for Annapolis County by taking the sever-  
al Oaths required by the Constitution and Form of  
Government and Laws of this State, and making and  
subscribing a Declaration of his belief in the Christian  
Religion, and also the Oath for the Support of the  
Constitution of the United States - Certificate thereof filed.

The Council adjourned till tomorrow morning
