The Council met

Present as on Monday

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Jacob Marshall Three pounds, ten shillings current Money for the like sum paid by him for two warrants obtained out of the land Office to effect Land lying within the reserves in Baltimore County

That the said Treasurer pay to John Davidson Esq<sup>r</sup> Thirty seven pounds, ten shillings for one quarter's Salary as a member of the Council

That the said Treasurer pay to James Bruce Esq<sup>r</sup> Thirty seven pounds, ten shillings for one quarter's Salary as a member of the Council

That the said Treasurer pay to Subb Fowler Eighteen pounds, fifteen shillings for one quarter's Salary as Messenger to the Council and Keeper of the State House and this day

Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 1792

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Col<sup>l</sup>: John A Stone Forty two pounds, three shillings and nine pence for three months half pay due the 1<sup>th</sup> instant
