

In Council April 4th 1792

Robert Orr of Kent County by his Petition sets forth that he was fined by the County Court of the said County at a March term last six pounds current Money for selling liquors without licence, which also appears by a transcript from the said Court. He also sets forth that he is very poor, has for some time been afflicted with a sore Arm, and has a family to support. He therefore prays to be released from the said fine. And the two Associate Justices of the said Court having represented him to be so extremely poor that nothing can be had of him, and recommending a remission of his fine. The Board do order and direct that the same be remitted on payment of all costs.
