

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Jubb Fowler Eighteen pounds, fifteen shillings for one quarter's Salary as Messenger the Council and Keeper of the State House due this Day.

William MacLaughlin of Baltimore Town is hereby appointed to collect all Sums of Money and Tobacco which did belong to Robert Christie late Sheriff of Baltimore County and were forfeited to the State except the public and County Dues in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly passed April 6th 1792.

Resolved that the said William MacLaughlin be allowed at the rate of ten per Cent on all monies he may collect in virtue of the said Resolution.

Resolved that the said William MacLaughlin before he proceeds to the said Collection shall give bond to the State of Maryland with two Securities to be approved by this Board in the penalty of five thousand pounds current Money for the faithful discharge of the Duty required of him by the said Resolution.
