Laughlin be allowed at the rate of ten per cent on
all monies he may collect in virtue of the said resolution.

Resolved that the said William Mac -
Laughlin before he proceeds to the said collection
shall give bond to the State of Maryland with
two Securities to be approved by this Board in the
penalty of five thousand pounds Current Money for
the faithful discharge of the duty required of him
by the said Resolution —
