May 2. 1792

The General Assembly having appropriated a Sum of Money to repair the State house in the City of Annapolis, any person or persons wishing to Contract for the same may see the designs and particulars of all the work to be done, on the first Monday in June next at the house of Mr Joseph Clark in this City, and on the Thursday following the Governor and Council will receive proposals for executing the Carpenters and plasterers work together or separately - The Contractor or Contractors are to find all materials, and necessary advances of Money will be made for the purchase thereof on Security being given.
