The Board having before them the

penters work thereof, with John Shaw Security
in the penalty of five hundred pounds for finishing
the same for the sum of five hundred pounds

Also with Thomas Dance in the
like penalty for finishing the Plasterers work
of the said Dome for the sum of six hundred
and ninety pounds upon the Supervisor, Mr
Joseph Clark's engaging to be answerable for
all advances made to the said Thomas Dance
by the direction of the said Clark, either that
work shall be done to the amount or
the materials that are purchased therewith
to the value thereof given up to the State
