Warfield Forty five pounds thirteen shillings and
ten pence specie agreeably to the "Act to Adjust
the Debts due from this State" per Certificate
of J. Bullen for a Horse received of Thomas
Harrison in the year 1781 liquidated by the
Auditor the 24 Instant

issue a Certificate for the Depreciation of pay to
Clement Sewell as Sergeant in the first Maryland
Regiment from the 4th March 1777 to the 14th

14 September to the 8th of April 1778 and de-
-liver the same to the Treasurer of the Western
Shore, who is ordered to pay it to the said
Clement Sewell
