

fell for one whole year, from the time he took out licence - that at the expiration of the said year he applied but found there was no adjourned Court of whom he could get licence until March following - that upon being presented he submitted to the Court, and was fined as aforesaid - that he has a numerous and helpless family to support, and is unable to pay the said fines without distressing them - He therefore prays a remission thereof - and three of the Justices of the said Court having recommended him to the Clemency of Government. The Board considering all the circumstances of his case do order and direct that the aforesaid fines be remitted on payment of all costs arising on the said Presentments -
