

In Council September 12th 1792
 Augustus Delarue of (Prince)
 Georges County by his Petition sets forth that
 he came to reside in the town of Bladens-
 burgh in October 1791 and opened a store for
 selling liquors about December, when a licence
 could not be obtained, but concluded that if
 he paid his money at the next Court it would
 be sufficient, and accordingly at April Court he
 took out licence, and informed the Court of what
 he had before done, and offered his money to
 pay for the time he had sold, but the
 Court informed him they had no power to
 receive it - that a Mr Dyer one of the Grand
 Jury coming to the knowledge of the above
 circumstances considered himself bound to
 present him - that he submitted to the Court
 and was fined according to Law - The Chief
 Justice and one of the Associate Justices having
 recommended the Petitioner - the Board taking
 into consideration all the circumstances attending
 his case do order and direct a remission of the
 aforesaid fine on payment of all the Costs
