Resolved that the Auditor credit Mess<sup>rs</sup> Daniel and Samuel Hughes with £1182.10 for Cannon bursted by being too high proved, and the sum of Twenty five pounds, Twelve shillings, for shot expended in proving the Cannon

Monday 8<sup>th</sup> October 1792

The Council met

Present as on Saturday the 22<sup>d</sup> Sep<sup>r</sup>

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Hugh Mc Coy late a private in the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment One pound, six shillings and eight pence pay from 1<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> August 1780 per Certificate from the Auditor General

That the said Treasurer pay to William Gilmour Thirty seven pounds, ten shillings on account

The Auditor General is requested to issue a Certificate for the Dequation of pay to William Ormond late a private in the second Maryland Regiment from last of April 1777 to 5<sup>th</sup> July 1778 and deliver the same to the Treasurer of the western Shore who is ordered to pay the same to the said William Ormond
