 said Court fined him thirty pounds, a sum fully
 equal to all he is worth. That for want of
 Money to pay the said fine he has been com-
 -mitted to Goal, where he has been confined for
 some time, and is now sick. That he has
 a wife and seven small Children, whose only prospect of
 support must depend entirely on his labour, and
 exertions - and several respectable Inhabitants
 of Baltimore having certified that the facts set
 forth are true and recommending a remission
 of the fine. and it also appearing by the
 Certificate of the Sheriff of the said County that
 he had given security for his future good behaviour.
 The Board in consideration of his poverty, and
 helpless family do order and direct the said
 fine of thirty pounds to be remitted on his paying
 all costs arising on the said Prosecution.
