-surer pay to Benjamin Mackall Esquire Fifty  
pounds for a quarter's Salary as one of the  
Judges of the Court of Appeals due the 1<sup>th</sup> instant

That the said Treasurer pay to  
John Hanson junior Forty one pounds, twelve  
shillings and some pence current money due  
him per Account passed by the Auditor
