

This present Session of Assembly entitled "an Act
 to provide for the filling the vacancy in the House
 of Representatives of the Congress of the United
 States occasioned by the resignation of Joshua Seney
 Esquire," must be filled by a Person residing with-
 in the second District of this ^{State}, as designated by
 the Act aforesaid passed November Session one thousand
 seven hundred and ninety. We do therefore in Pur-
 suance of the powers vested in us by the Constitution
 of the United States and by the aforesaid Acts of
 Assembly, authorize and command you to hold an
 Election for a person to represent this State in the
 said House of Representatives, in your said County of
 — on a Monday the seventh day of January next
 at the usual place of holding Elections and that after
 giving ten Days notice at the least excluding the
 Day of notice and the Day of Election you then
 and there attend, conduct regulate and make return
 of the said election agreeably to the directions of
 the aforesaid Act of Assembly passed November Session
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety.
