The Council met

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurers pay to John Wilmot Twelve pounds, eight shillings and nine pence for riding Express to Talbot Queen Anns, Kent and Cecil Counties with Writs of Election for a Representative to Congress. —

Commission issued to William Frank Esq<sup>r</sup> of Charles County, appointed Chief Justice of the fifth District, in the room of Richard Potts Esq<sup>r</sup> who has resigned. —

Randolph Brandt Latimer Esq<sup>r</sup> appointed Agent by the General Assembly in "an Act to appoint an Agent for the year 1793," executed a Bond with Charles Wallace and Benjamin Harwood his securities in the penalty of twenty thousand pounds well and truly to perform the duties required by the said Act with a certificate of his qualification before the Chancellor endorsed thereon, which is approved and sent to the Treasurer of the western Shore. —
