The Board took into consideration the application of Mary Magruder late the widow of Lieutenant Reginald Killeary, setting forth that she had agreeably to an act of assembly passed at November session 1785 received during her widowhood a pension of Sixty pounds per annum, being a sum equal to the half pay of the said Lieutenant Killeary who died in the service of the United States - That having lately intermarried with a certain Samuel Magruder of Prince Georges County, her right to the said Pension was forfeited - and praying that it might be continued to her two children by the said Killeary  
whereupon
