In Council March 25. 1793

James Webster by his Petition sets forth that he was recognized to appear before the Justices of Baltimore County Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery in the Term of Twenty pounds Current Money to a November term last, for assaulting a certain John Manley, at which term he the Petitioner did appear and waited at Court three days, during which time the said Manley did not appear. That he the Petitioner was obliged to go to Virginia during the sitting of the said Court and in his absence the said Manley appeared and the Petitioner's Recognizance was forfeited. Three of the Justices of the said Court having recommended a release of the said forfeited Recognizance. It is hereby ordered to be released on payment of all Costs —
