The Board took into consideration the Petition of Joseph Dawson, setting forth that he was presented and upon Submission fined three pence fifteen shillings by the Court of Dorchester at its October term 1792 for selling a quart of Cyder contrary to Law, and praying to be relieved from the payment thereof. The Petitioner represents that he was ignorant of the Law - that he is a cripple, and has a family who would suffer by the execution of the fine - and the Justices of the said Court having recommended him as an Object of Clemency the said fine is hereby remitted
