was fined the sum of Fifty pounds on each prosecu-  
tion - The Chief Justice of the district and one of  
the Associates of the said County of Montgomery  
having recommended a remission of the fines, and  
the Board having inducements to believe that it  
was through a misconstruction of the Law that  
the Offences were committed, do order that the said  
fines amounting to one hundred pounds be remitted  
upon payment of all costs.
