It appearing to the Board on the representation of Jacob Comeggs of Kent County and by the representation of the Chief Justice and the Associate Justices of said County, that the said Jacob Comeggs was presented in the Court of the said County for not keeping the public roads in his care in good order according to law by which the said Comeggs incurred the forfeiture of five pounds of Tobacco by the Judgment of the said Court, and it appearing further by the Representation aforesaid that the said Comeggs was confined by a long illness and bad health so as to be unable to perform the duties of an overseer of the road - and that the said Comeggs's case deserves the interposition of this Board - It is therefore ordered that the said forfeiture be remitted,
