

Ordered that the western Shore Treas-
-urer pay to Col: Uriah Forrest thirty three pounds
fifteen shillings for three months half pay due
from the 1st instant.

That the said Treasurer pay to Sam: C
Chase Esquire one hundred and fifty pounds for
one quarter's Salary as Chief Judge of the
General Court due the 1st instant.
