

Ordered that the western Shore Treasuror pay to Col: Uriah Forrest thirty three pounds fifteen shillings for three months half pay due from the 1st instant.

That the said Treasurer pay to Saml. Chase Esquire one hundred and fifty pounds for one quarter's Salary as Chief Judge of the General Court due the 1st instant.
