

According to order, the Board proceeded to the consideration of the Charges exhibited by Charles Daffin against George Martin Surveyor of Caroline County and after hearing evidence, and the observations of Counsel for each of the parties, it was Unanimously determined that the said Charges are entirely unsupported by testimony and appear to be a wanton attack on the Character and fortune of the accused and that therefore the Representation of the said Charles Daffin in which the said Charges are contained be dismissed with full Costs, to be taxed by the Clerk of the Council
