

In Council June 5th 1793.

By a representation from the Chief and Associate Justices of the Court of Queen Anne's County, it appears that a certain Margaret Bateman has been fined by the said Court seven hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco for keeping an Ordinary without licence - The Justices aforesaid represent that the woman is exceedingly poor and has a number of small children who would have been a charge to the County but for her exertions - They therefore recommended a remission of the fine, and the Board in consideration of her poverty do direct that upon her paying all costs, the fine imposed on her as aforesaid be remitted.
