Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to John Randall Twenty four pounds, fifteen shillings and five pence due him per Account passed by the Auditor —

William McLaughlin of Baltimore town is hereby appointed to collect all sums of Money and Tobacco which did belong to Robert Christie late Sheriff of Baltimore County, and were forfeited to the State, except the public and County dues, in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly passed the 22 December 1792.
