

Friday 26<sup>th</sup> July 1793

The Council met

Present as on Wednesday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Wilnot nine pounds, eight shillings, and two pence due him per account passed by the Auditor

John Smoot of Dorchester County is hereby appointed on the part of this State to ascertain in conjunction with a person to be named by Richard Waters of the said County, the quantity of the land purchased by the said Waters on a Tantcoke manor, which is clear of dispute, for which quantity when ascertained the said Waters is to pay in the same manner as those who have installed their debts, agreeably to a resolution of the General Assembly passed a November Session 1792.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to William Gilmour thirty seven pounds, ten shillings on account.
