

Mary Marshall by her Petition sets forth that she is very infirm and weak, and is lame in one of her legs, and that she is reduced to poverty - that finding by retailing liquors she could keep from the poor house she retailed Spintuous liquors, for which she was presented in the Criminal Court for Baltimore County at the present August term and fined for the same - The Grand Jury who found the presentment having recommended the Petitioner as an Object of Charity, and the Chief Judge and two of the Justices of the said Court having recommended a remission of the said fine - It is ordered that the said fine be remitted upon payment of all costs
