

In Council September 14th 1793.

William Templeman of Arm Arundel County by his Petition sets forth, that at the last Arm Arundel County Court he was fined six hundred pounds of Tobacco for selling liquor contrary to Law - that from age and infirmity he is reduced to such poor and indigent circumstances it is with the utmost difficulty he can procure himself the common necessaries of life, and that in this situation and through necessity he sold the said liquor and prays a remission of the said fine, and promises not to violate the law in future - and it appearing by a Certificate of the Clerk of the said Court that the fine was imposed at April Term last - The Board in consideration of his indigent circumstances, and the recommendation of two of the Associate Justices of the said Court do order that the said fine of six hundred pounds of Tobacco be remitted upon all costs being paid -
