Balthazard Bouyer and Pierre Monpoy formerly subjects of France appeared before the Board, and voluntarily made repeated and subscribed a declaration of their belief in the Christian Religion, and also took repeated and subscribed the Oath prescribed by the "Act for Naturalization," wherefore they are now become subjects of this State,

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Killy Esquire Thirty seven pounds, ten shillings for one quarter's Salary as a Member of the Council due the 1st August last.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Shaw Fifty pounds for the purchase of wood for the public on Account,
