In Council September 20. 1793

Whereas it appears by the Petition of John Hay of Harford County, that there has been for some time past, a ferry over Gunpowder river from Joppa where he resides - that he had licences to keep the said ferry for two years - that in the year 1791 he applied to the County Court of Harford to renew his licence which was objected to by Mr. Rumsfy who claimed the landing place as his property - that while the matter was before the Court his wife had, put over, a person for whom he was presented and fined - The Board on consideration of the circumstances and the recommendation of the Justices of the said Court do order that the fine amounting to five pounds, as appears by a certificate from the Clerk of the said County be remitted upon all debts being paid
