-pectation that he violated the laws of the State,
that the forfeiture if exacted will involve himself
and large family in ruin, and his securities in
great distress. Three of the Justices of the said
Court with a number of the Citizens of Baltimore
Town having recommended the Petitioner and
having solicited the interposition of the Executive
it is ordered that the said forfeiture be remitted
upon all costs being paid — James Bruce.
