The Petition of Joshua Groves of Prince Georges County, praying to be released from a fine imposed on him by the County Court of the said County at September term last for retailing Spirituous liquor contrary to law, was rejected.

William Whately appointed an associate Justice of Caroline County in the room of Gabriel Potter deceased and Commission issued to Henry Downes and William Whately Associate Justices of the said Court.
