

Ten shillings for the like sum paid into the Treasury by Thomas Russell for land warrants issued in 1782 to locate within the reserves of Baltimore County and assigned to the said James & Gill & others —

The Petition of Joshua Groves of Prince Georges County, praying to be released from a fine imposed on him by the County Court of the said County at September term last for retailing spiritous liquor contrary to law, was rejected.

William Whiteley appointed an associate Justice of Caroline County in the room of Gabriel Potter deceased and Commission issued to Henry Downes and William Whiteley associate Justices of the said Court.
