

Tuesday, November 26<sup>th</sup> 1793

The Council met: Present, His Excellency the Governor and  
The Honourable William Pinkney, John Davidson, and Henry Ridgely Esquires.

An order was issued on the Treasurer of the Western Shore to Benj. Rumsey Esq.  
for fifty pounds current money, being one quarter's salary as a Judge of the Court of  
Appeals, ending the 1<sup>st</sup> Instant.

Orders were issued in like manner to Benjamin Mackall Esq. for one hundred  
pounds, being his salary as a Judge of the Court of Appeals, for six months  
ending the first instant.

To Thomas Jones Esquire, for one hundred pounds; being his salary  
as a Judge of the Court of Appeals, for six months; ending the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

To John Davidson Esq., for Thirty seven pounds, ten shillings, being  
his salary as a Member of the Council for one quarter, ending the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

To Henry Ridgely Esq., for Thirty seven pounds, ten shillings, being  
his salary as a Member of the Council, for one quarter, ending the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

To John Kilty Esq., for Thirty seven pounds ten shillings, being  
his salary, as a Member of the Council, for one quarter, ending the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

To Samuel Chase Esquire, for one hundred and fifty pounds, being  
his salary as Chief Justice of the General Court, for one quarter, ending the 1<sup>st</sup> Instant.

Wednesday, November 27<sup>th</sup> 1793

The Council met: Present, as on the day preceeding.

An order was issued on the Treasurer of the Western Shore to  
William Pinkney Esq. for one hundred and fifty pounds: being his salary as a  
Member of the Council for one year, ending the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

Thursday, November 28<sup>th</sup> 1793

The Council met - present, as before

Orders were issued on the Treasurer of the Western Shore, to  
Thomas Johnson junior, for one hundred and twenty five pounds; being  
his salary as Clerk of the Council for six months, ending the 1<sup>st</sup> instant; and  
for Twenty two pounds ten shillings, allowed by His Excellency, the  
Governor, for six months board to Miss Maria Grason; ending as aforesaid.

Nathaniel Rochester was appointed an Associate Justice of  
Washington County Court, in the room of Thomas Sprigg Esq., whose seat  
was vacated by his becoming a Member of the House of Representatives of  
the United States. A Commission was issued accordingly, to John Scott and N.R.
