

Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup> 1793.

The Council met.

Present His Excellency the Governor, and the same Members as on the preceding day.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Ryzinger three pounds fifteen shillings for riding express to Baltimore with dispatches for the Collector of the Customs.

Saturday December the 14<sup>th</sup> 1793.

The Council met. Present as on Thursday.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Gilmer eighteen pounds fifteen shillings on account for repairs of the State House.

Thursday, December the 19<sup>th</sup> 1793

The Council met. Present as on the 14<sup>th</sup>.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Luther Martin Esq<sup>r</sup> eighty seven pounds ten shillings, as a compensation for his services in the suit in the Supreme Court of the United States between this State and Mess<sup>rs</sup> Van Staphorst.

Saturday, December the 21<sup>st</sup> 1793.

The Council met. Present as on Thursday.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Reid (Hair dresser) five pounds twelve shillings and six pence, due him as per account passed by the Governor, for dressing Tho<sup>t</sup> Walley to the 26<sup>th</sup> of August last.
