

Monday the 23rd December - 1793.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and the Hon.
William Pinkney, John Davidson and Henry Bridgely Esqrs.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James McHenry
for the use of John Caldwell Esquire of Philadelphia, Thirty five pounds: being
the sum allowed the said Caldwell in full compensation for his services in the
suit lately instituted against this State in the supreme Court of the United
States, by Mess^{rs} Van Staphorst of Amsterdam.

Tuesday the 24th December 1793. Present as yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Leon^d Coll
Mriah Forrest for thirty three pounds fifteen shillings; being three months half pay
ending the first day of November last.

Thursday, December the 26th 1793

The Council met. Present as on the 24th.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Abraham
Cambell an invalid soldier late of the Maryland line, Two pounds five shillings
being his allowance for one quarter, ending the first of November last, agreeably to
a resolution passed by the General Assembly at a November session 1791.

Tuesday, December the 31st 1793

The Council met. Present as on the 26th.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Christop^r
Richmond Esq^r two hundred and twenty five pounds Current money for his services
as Agent and those of John Wright as Deputy Agent for settling the
