

Friday, January the 10th 1794.

The Council met. Present as on the 8th.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Stephen Clark three pounds fifteen shillings, being his account for binding and letter two large record books for the use of the Board.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Kelly Clerk of the Council five pounds thirteen shillings and nine pence, five pounds ten shillings, whereof for the use of David Patton of Baltimore for two Record Books for the use of the Board, and the remainder to reimburse the said Kelly the expence of Carriage.

From the 10th to the 16th The Council met daily, and were employed in arranging the appointments of Justices of the Peace. &c.

Thursday, January the 16th 1794.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Hon^{ble}

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Brice Esquire Thirty seven pounds ten shillings, for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, ending the first of November last.

Friday, January the 17th 1794.

The Council met. Present as yesterday.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Fowler Twelve pounds ten shillings for one quarter's boarding of Thomas Walley, ending the 11th instant, as per account allowed by the Governor, and passed by the Auditor.
