Inspectors of the Central Warehouse in Montgomery County.

Monday, January the 20<sup>th</sup>. 1794

The Council met: Present as on the 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Thomas Lyles was re-appointed and John McGill appointed  
Inspectors of Queen Anne Warehouse in Prince George's County. Certificate  
of appointment sent to Lyles and commission issued to McGill accordingly.

Monday, February the 3<sup>rd</sup>. 1794

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and  
The Members who attended on the 27<sup>th</sup>. (The interim employed  
in the arrangement  
of civil appointments)

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to  
Col John Hoskins Stone forty two pounds three shillings and nine pence  
for three months half pay as an invalid Officer, ending the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John Bowen, an  
invalid Officer late of the Maryland Line Eleven pounds five shillings  
for three months half pay, due the first instant.

Tuesday, February the 4<sup>th</sup>. 1794

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor,  
and the Members attending Yesterday.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to  
M<sup>rs</sup> Anne Le Vaucher fifteen pounds, for one quarter's pension, due  
the first instant.
