

Ordered That the Auditor be requested to liquidate and pay the claim of Doctor Samuel I Coale for the sum of £1000 Continental money loaned by him to the State in May 1780, according to the scale of depreciation established by the Act of May 1791 - that is to say, at sixty for one.

(The said claim having been adjusted by the Auditor)

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Doctor Samuel I Coale sixteen pounds thirteen shillings and four pence, with interest from the 11<sup>th</sup> of May 1780, agreeably to an Act to adjust the Debts due from this State.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Jones Esquire fifty pounds, for one quarters salary as a Judge of the Court of Appeals, due the first instant.
