It appearing to the Board by the Petition of John Levant that at the Court
of Oyer and Terminer &c for Baltimore County held in January last he was prosecuted
for retailing spiritous liquors without licence; and that on submission to the Court
he was adjudged to pay six pounds current money the penalty annexed to
the Commission of such offence, which said Sum he prays may be remitted,
and it further appearing to the Board that the said John Levant being a foreigner
late arrived in this Country, violated the Law through ignorance, which fact
being fully ascertained by the Certificate of four of the Justices of the said Court
who recommend a remission of the said penalty, It is therefore Ordained
that the same be, and it is hereby remitted, on the payment of the same
by the said John Levant, the Petitioner.
