

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Owen four ten pounds, thirteen shillings and nine pence, for services made on Lacksah and Panguinack's Manors in Charles County under an appointment from the Board; as per account passed by the Auditor.

From this Day to the 20th, the Council was daily employed in nominating &c^a preparatory to the carrying into execution the Act to regulate and discipline the Militia.

Thursday February the 20th 1794.

The Council met. Present The Hon^{ble} John Davidson,
James Brice and Henry Ridgely Esquires.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Perry jun^r, seven pounds ten shillings for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Senate, due the first instant.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Green ninety three pounds, fifteen shillings for one quarter's salary as Printer to the State, due the first instant. New Commission of the peace issued to Kent County leaving out one: Nicholls and adding Andrew Wiersenthal and John Bondley Esq^r.

Friday February the 21st 1794.

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor, and
The Hon^{ble} William Pinkney John Davidson
James Brice and Henry Ridgely Esquires.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Green, Printer to the State, twenty nine pounds, sixteen shillings and 1/2, for sundry publications; as per account passed the 17th instant by the Auditor.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Shaw, Armorer &c Ninety five pounds three shillings and one penny to be taken accounted for.
