The Council met. Present The Hon^{ble} John Davidson
Henry Ridgely and Christopher Richmond Esq^{rs}

It appearing to the Board by the representation of the Sheriff of
Washington County that he cannot perform the duties imposed on him by the
appointment of this Board, to return a List of the Inhabitants of the said
County, subject to Militia duty by the time prescribed by the Law, and that
unless he is indulged a few weeks longer, he must decline taking
upon him the execution of the duties aforesaid; and the Board being
satisfied of the difficulty of getting a proper person to accept the same, and
the impossibility of his performing the duties required in so short a time,
do therefore order that the Sheriff of Washington County be and he is
herby indulged with a reasonable time to complete the return aforesaid,
not exceeding the third Tuesday in May next.
