Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward Roberts seven pounds fifteen shillings for riding exp^{ts} to the Eastern Shore with bonds, as per account paid by the Auditor.

Tuesday, March 18th 1796.

The Council met. Present as yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore issue to Jason Jenkins a Certificate for sixty pounds nine shillings and four pence Currency in lieu a depreciation Certificate for the like sum issued to the said Jenkins on the 1st June 1795 by John Turner then Auditor General, which Certificate is duly proved to have been lost on the 12th of September 1796, and never to have been renewed or cancelled by the State. The Certificate so to be issued to Jason Jenkins from the 1st of August 1796.
