Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Clark Architect (superintending the public repairs) Two hundred pounds on account.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward Roberts Eight pounds two shillings, for going express to the Eastern Shore with public letters, as per account passed by the Auditor.

Thursday, April the 3<sup>rd</sup> 1794.

The Council met. Present as Yesterday

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William A. Vedham late a per cent in the Maryland Sine five pounds, twelve shillings and six pence for one quarters pension ending the first of February last.

Commission was issued to Burton Wheteroff, appointed Notary Public for the City of Annapolis, and Anne Arundel County, in the room of John Randall Esq<sup>r</sup> who resigned on 21<sup>st</sup> of March last.
