

Monday April 7th 1794.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and
The Hon^{ble} John Davidson, H^{on} Ridgely and Richmond Es^{rs}.

Henry Whetcroft was appointed and commissioned one of the
Coroners of Anne Arundel County in the room of Burton Whetcroft, deceased.

Wednesday the 9th April 1794.

The Council met. Present The Hon^{ble} John Davidson
Henry Ridgely and Christopher Richmond Es^{rs}.

By a representation from the Chief Justice and one of the Associate
Justices of Kent County, accompanied by an official Transcript of the Proceeding,
it appears that at March term 1794 a presentment was found against, and
on submission, the legal fine imposed upon Daniel Knock & Company, for
retailing spiritous liquors without license. The said Justices set forth that the
penalty was incurred through the mistake of the said Knock & Co who thought
themselves authorized to sell liquor under a license granted to W^m Thomas & Co,
all the partners of which house were afterwards included in the firm of Knock
& Co. The said Justices therefore recommend a remission of the fine except the sum
of two pounds ten shillings which the State would otherwise lose by the said
mistake; and the Board believing that the facts are truly represented do order
that the said remission be made accordingly.
