

Friday, May the 2<sup>nd</sup>. 1794.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and  
all the Members.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay  
to William Harwood Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings Current money for  
one quarter's salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Kilty  
Sixty two pounds ten shillings for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the  
Council, ending and due as aforesaid.

That the said Treasurer pay to James Bruce  
Esquire Fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council,  
due as aforesaid.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jubb Fowler  
Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's salary as Messenger to  
the Council and Keeper of the Court House, due as aforesaid.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jubb Fowler  
Thirteen pounds thirteen shillings for services performed and money advanced for  
contingencies, as per account passed by the Auditor.
