

Wednesday, May the 14th 1794.

The Council met; Present His Excellency the Governor, & the Hon^{ble} John Davidson

James Brice and Christopher Richmond Esquires

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Spencer Cooper twenty pounds, for making and returning to this Board a list of the Citizens of Allegany County, liable to Militia service.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Green Printer to the State, twenty six pounds sixteen shillings and three pence for printing Militia Commissions and circular letters to the field Officers.

That the said Treasurer pay to Archibald Robinson Esq^r six pounds seven shillings and six pence, for so much advanced by him to defray the expence of seizing and detaining the french Privateer Industry in August last. (see Letter of the 23rd August 1793 to the Secretary of War.)

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Denny Esq^r Fifty pounds, for a quarter's salary as Auditor, due the 1st instant

Thursday, May the 15th 1794.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and the Hon^{ble} James Brice, Henry Ridgely and Christ^{ch} Richmond Esq^r

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore pay to Benj^{am} Jones fourteen pounds nineteen shillings for making and returning to this Board a list of the Citizens of Somerset County liable to Militia service

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Chase Esq^r one hundred and fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as Chief Judge of the General Court; due the 1st instant

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Henry Ridgely Fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due the first instant
